

Hall of mirrors

Clever design ideas abound in this stylish London flat, helping to create a dramatic sense of light and space

Essentially a wide hallway with a room at either end, this London apartment feels light and deceptively large thanks to a judicious use of mirrors and a great eye for design. Walls along the entire hallway have been covered with mirrors, making the entrance to the flat open and welcoming. Push one and you find yourself in the bathroom. The hall is also home to a workspace and much-needed storage. In the living room, more mirrors are in evidence, covering the left-hand wall and bouncing around light and views from outside, helping the room feel both larger and lighter.

Throughout the apartment, the furniture is visually light and flexible, from the glossy Vitra 'Panton' chairs (available at the Aram Store) that double as desk and dining chairs to the bespoke hide-away dining table. In the bedroom, furniture has been carefully considered. The bed with its integral bedside table is a clever space saver and the bedside light is visually discreet, too. Sleek kitchen units are handle-free, a style that's echoed in the bathroom – keeping the palette consistent is one way to make a space feel larger. The Bisazza tiles in the bathroom soften the room, one of the few highly decorative touches in the apartment ➔

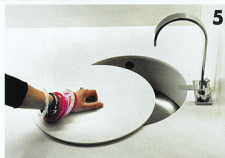
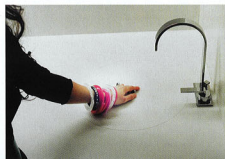
